5. All artwork must be completed solely by the child participant with no outside help.
6. Submissions can be emailed to librarystaff@irwindaleca.gov or placed in the Library’s curbside book drop located on the north side of Calle de Paseo. All entries MUST BE SUBMITTED BY TUESDAY, JUNE 30, to be eligible for prizes.
